Dvoor Farm Bird Walk at June 23 Farmers' Market

FLEMINGTON – Explore the bird habitat of the Hunterdon Land Trust's Dvoor Farm on Sunday, June 23 at 8:30 a.m.

Juanita Hummel, of the Washington Crossing Audubon Society, will lead this free hour-long bird walk. She'll stop at several habitat sites and discuss why their preservation was vital for birds and other wildlife.

Red-tailed hawks, yellow-bellied sapsuckers are among the dozens of species spotted on the farm in previous walks.

Hummel, an avid birder and nature lover, currently serves on the board of the Washington Crossing Audubon Society, and volunteers with the NJ Audubon Society, the Wildlife Conservation Corps and other conservation organizations.

At 9 a.m., HLT's Farmers' Market opens with more than 20 local farmers and vendors offering organic produce, grass-fed beef, pork, chicken, yak, honey, artisan breads, cheese, granola, native plants and more. Visitors can enjoy a flatbread pizza made with ingredients provided by local farmers or homemade bureks. The market also has pastries, muffins, yogurt, bread, coffee and more.
